The search is on for candidates to fill each of the spots and the council is expected to have its inaugural meeting in May.

"This is an exciting opportunity for the right people to make a very real difference and support us in our ongoing efforts to deliver best care to everyone," Mr Price says. "Their input will be invaluable in the design, planning and delivery of high-quality, safe and accessible health care services with a strong focus on better patient experience."
