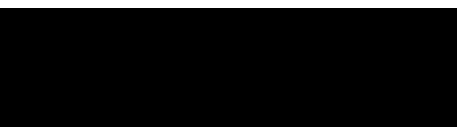

In response to your request, we are able to provide the following information:

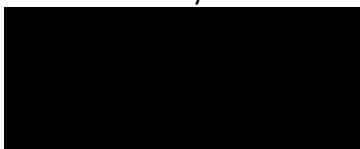
I am interested in the activities (and any planned activities) of Waitematā DHB regarding the current political movement in West Auckland to remove the licensing trust monopoly.
