Your Official Information Act request, reference: HNZ2162 - Number of GPs employed

Thank you for your Official Information Act request received 19 July seeking information from Te Whatu Ora-Health New Zealand Waitematā about the number of GPs employed.

Before responding to your specific questions, it may be useful to provide some context about our services. Waitematā is the largest and one of the most rapidly growing health districts in the country, serving a population of around 650,000 across the North Shore, Waitakere and Rodney areas. We are the largest employer in the district, employing more than 8,900 people across more than 80 locations.

In addition to providing care to our own resident population, we are the Northern Region provider of forensic mental health services and child rehabilitation services, plus the metro Auckland provider of child community dental services and community alcohol and drug services.

In response to your request, we are able to provide the following information:

How many DHBs, if any, employ GPs and in what roles, listed by DHB, role and number of people?

Three GPs are employed permanently by Waitematā in the following roles:

- Clinical Director, Primary Care
- Primary Care Advisor
- Clinical Leader.

Other roles that GPs are contracted to are:

- Clinical Leader
- Rural Alliance Members, of which there are five
- Primary Care Advisor: Hepatitis C Programme.

I trust that this information is helpful.

Waitematā supports the open disclosure of information to assist community understanding of how we are delivering publicly funded healthcare.

This includes the proactive publication of anonymised Official Information Act responses on our website from 10 working days after they have been released.

If you consider there are good reasons why this response should not be made publicly available, we will be happy to consider your views.
