Re: OIA request - Number of babies born

Thank you for your Official Information Act request received 6 July 2018 seeking the following of Waitemata District Health Board (DHB):

"I'm writing to request figures for the number of babies born for the year June 2017 to June 2018, with a breakdown of mother's ages.

In conjunction, I'd also like to request a breakdown of numbers of births at North Shore and Waitakere hospitals and community birthing centres. As well as a breakdown of vaginal and caesarean births. Both for June 2017 to June 2018"

Waitemata DHB cares for the largest patient population of any DHB in New Zealand, currently standing at just over 630,000 people and operates two maternity facilities – one at North Shore Hospital and one at Waitakere Hospital.

The table below details the numbers of births by age group for North Shore and Waitakere Maternity Units for the period July 2017 – June 2018 (12 months) and separates the births by type of birth (vaginal or caesarean).

The rate of vaginal birth at Waitakere Hospital is higher than North Shore, for several reasons, including age and women with highly complex pregnancy issues are advised to give birth at North Shore Hospital due to the availability of the Intensive Care Unit, should it be needed.

At present, there are three primary birthing units operating within the Waitemata DHB catchment –

Warkworth Birthing Centre, Helensville Birthing Centre and Wellsford Birthing Unit (one bed). The following table is a breakdown of births at these units (please note: information on births by age not available).
